Four Agencies Join AARP for Batesville Town Hall Meeting

LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS (October 4, 2010) —Four state agencies are partnering this year with the Arkansas chapter of the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) to hold a town hall-style meeting in Batesville on Friday, October 8, 2010, at the White River Medical Center, 1710 Harrison Street. The Arkansas Insurance Department joins the Office of the Attorney General, the Department of Human Services Division of Aging and Adult Services, and the Arkansas Securities Department to present this meeting for seniors which will focus on fraud in insurance, securities, and Medicare as well as general discussions on senior issues.
