REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, the matter of Nathaniel Kent (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Hearing Officer and her recommendations to the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 42100 and resides in Blytheville, Arkansas.
2. Respondent’s producer license was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2013-049 for being three (3) or more months in arrearage on his child support obligation, as reported by the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement.
3. An administrative hearing was held on June 18, 2013, with Chief Deputy Commissioner Lenita Blasingame serving as the duly appointed Hearing Officer.
4. Respondent appeared at the hearing and offered testimony regarding his child support arrearages, and the factual and circumstantial reasons for the arrearages.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

6. The Commissioner is required to suspend the Respondent's producer license pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239(d) upon notice from the Office of Child Support Enforcement that a licensee is three (3) or more months in arrears on a child support obligation.

7. Under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14), the failure to comply with an order imposing a child support obligation is grounds for revoking a producer's license.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before her, the Hearing Officer recommends:

8. That the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 42100 should be immediately revoked as of the date of this Order.


