REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, the matter of William G. King (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Hearing Officer and her Recommendations, the Commissioner finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 300149.
2. On September 19, 2013, it was reported to the Criminal Investigation Division of the Department that the Respondent was in arrears on his child support obligation in the District of Columbia and owed both federal and state income taxes.
3. Respondent improperly answered “No” to the question of whether he had any child support obligation in arrears on his original application for a producer license as well as his 2010 and 2011 renewals.

4. On October 8, 2013, the Respondent's producer license was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2013-098, which recounts the Respondent's conduct and is incorporated herein by reference.

5. An administrative hearing was held on November 14, 2013, with Chief Deputy Commissioner Lenita Blasingame serving as the duly appointed Hearing Officer. The Department and the Respondent submitted exhibits, all of which were admitted into the record.

6. Respondent was unable to demonstrate payment of his debts, including the child support arrearage and federal and state income taxes.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103 and other provisions of the Arkansas Insurance Code.

8. Pursuant to the Arkansas Insurance Code, the Commissioner may revoke an insurance producer's license for providing misleading or materially untrue information on a producer license application. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(1).

9. Failure to comply with a child support obligation is grounds for the revocation of a producer's license. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14).

10. Respondent's actions demonstrate financial irresponsibility and untrustworthiness, which are grounds for the revocation of a producer's license. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8).

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before her, the Hearing Officer recommends:

11. That the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 300149 should be immediately revoked as of the date of this Order.


