EMERGENCY SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day, the emergency matter of Danette Elise Morgan (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Associate Counsel, Amanda Capps Rose, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103. The Commissioner has the authority to issue emergency license suspensions pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-64-216(e) and 25-15-211(c).
2. Respondent is licensed to write life, accident, health and sickness insurance and holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 300629.
3. Respondent’s last known address is 5916 Willow Wood Lane, Dallas, Texas 75252.
4. The Department’s License Division has received notice from the Texas Insurance Department that the Respondent’s Texas Resident Producer License is no longer active. The Texas Insurance Commissioner revoked the Respondent’s license effective September 4, 2009.
5. The public health, safety, and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:


6. In order to receive a nonresident producer license in Arkansas, the producer must hold a license as a resident in good standing in his or her home state pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-508(a)(1).

7. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(9), the Commissioner may revoke an insurance producer's license if the producer has had an insurance producer license or its equivalent denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state.

8. For the public health, safety, and welfare of the people of this State, the Commissioner concludes that the Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 300629 should be and hereby is immediately suspended pending an administrative hearing.

9. An administrative hearing has been scheduled for November 18, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-216(e), and notice of the same is being provided to the Respondent simultaneously with this Order.
