ORDER

On this day, the matter of Michael J. Watkins (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Department was represented by Amanda Capps Rose.

GENERAL STIPULATIONS

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 353786 and resides in Little Rock, Arkansas. Respondent’s producer license was previously suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2010-102.

3. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2010-102 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a), although the Respondent’s producer license will be reinstated and the suspension lifted, the grounds for suspension allow for the


license to be placed on probationary status for a period of one (1) year.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 353786 is hereby REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted. Respondent's producer license will remain in probationary status for a period of one (1) year from the date of this Order.

6. At least once every three (3) months, the Respondent shall provide evidence of continued compliance with the installment agreements with the IRS and with the Office of Child Support Enforcement.
