**REVOCATION ORDER**

---

On this day, the matter of Robert Edward Dupree (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 19863 and resides in Little Rock, Arkansas. Respondent’s producer license is currently suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2010-083.
3. On or about September 7, 2010, the Department received notice from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement that the Respondent is three (3) or more months in arrearage on his child support obligation.
4. An Emergency Suspension Order was issued on October 11, 2010 due to the child support arrearage, and an administrative hearing was scheduled for November 17, 2010.
5. The administrative hearing was conducted as scheduled, and the Respondent was given the opportunity to testify and present evidence.

6. Following the administrative hearing, Mr. Dupree was advised in writing that his producer license would be reinstated if he provided evidence of a payment plan with the Office of Child Support Enforcement and displayed at least one month of compliance with the plan no later than February 17, 2011.

7. The Department contacted the Office of Child Support Enforcement after February 17, 2011 and received written confirmation that the Respondent is still in arrearage and has made no payment agreement with that office.

8. Respondent has not contacted this Department to arrange for any extension of the February deadline.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

9. Under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a), the failure to comply with an order imposing a child support obligation is grounds for revocation of a producer's license.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 19863 is hereby REVOKED. Respondent shall not conduct the business of insurance in the State of Arkansas unless and until he obtains a producer license at a future date consistent with the provisions of the Arkansas Insurance Code.
