**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**

Now on this day the matter of Arkansas Certificate of Authority No. 1805 of AMERICAN FINANCIAL SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, NAIC No. 69337 (“Company”), a Missouri-domiciled insurer, is taken under consideration by Jay Bradford, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas (“Commissioner”), as presented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, Legal Division of the Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) and by the Finance Division of the Department. From the facts, matters and other things before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Company is an accident and health insurer domiciled in Missouri. The Company’s Arkansas Certificate of Authority was suspended on June 3, 1993 pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 93-31 due to receivership proceedings instituted in the Company’s domiciliary state.
2. On July 21, 2008, the Missouri Insurance Department conditionally approved the purchase of the Company by American Financial Security Holdings, Inc. Accordingly, the Company has requested reinstatement of its Arkansas Certificate of Authority.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter involved

herein.

4. On this date, the Commissioner has determined that the Arkansas Certificate of Authority should be reinstated and the previous suspension rescinded.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Arkansas Certificate of Authority of American Financial Security Life Insurance Company is hereby immediately reinstated and A.I.D. Order No. 93-31 is hereby rescinded.
