**REINSTATEMENT ORDER**

---

On this day, the emergency matter of Patrick S. Prince (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 and resides in Sherwood, Arkansas. Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2012-304 on April 18, 2012.
2. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2012-304 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated. Reinstatement of the Respondent’s license is contingent upon remaining current under the Installment Agreement for Unpaid Child Support dated April 24, 2012.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239, the Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 should be reinstated based upon a Notice of Release received from

the Office of Child Support Enforcement dated February 16, 2012 requesting reinstatement of the Respondent's license.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

4. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 is hereby REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.

5. This Reinstatement Order shall replace A.I.D. Order No. 2012-304.
