ORDER

On this day, the matter of Pearl Mae Jenkins (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Ava Franks, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 350150 (“License”) and resides in Jacksonville, Arkansas.
2. On or about January 22, 2014, the Department received notification that a judgment, Case No. CV 08-9799, (“Judgment”) had been entered against Respondent.
3. A hearing took place April 17, 2014 to determine if Respondent is financially responsible and has good business reputation so that she may retain her License.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

5. The Commissioner has the authority to place a License on probation or suspend for lack of good business reputation or financial responsibility, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before her, the Hearing Officer recommends:

6. Respondent's Resident Producer License No. 350150 is suspended for sixty (60) days.

7. Respondent shall make monthly payments starting after the suspension to satisfy the Judgment against her.

8. Respondent's monthly payments shall be no less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month, payable by the last business day of each month.

9. At the close of the sixty (60) day suspension, Respondent's Resident Producer License No. 350150 shall be placed on probation until the Judgment is paid.

10. Respondent shall submit a monthly electronic report ("Reports") to the Department that details the amount paid and the amount outstanding on the Judgment.

11. Respondent shall submit these Reports to the Department until the Judgment is satisfied.

12. The Reports shall be submitted to the Department no later than one week after the last business day of each month.

13. Respondent shall submit an electronic spreadsheet that accounts for each payment after the final payment on the Judgment.



18. Respondent shall submit a monthly electronic report ("Reports") to the Department that details the amount paid and the amount outstanding on the Judgment.
19. Respondent shall submit these Reports to the Department until the Judgment is satisfied.
20. The Reports shall be submitted to the Department no later than one week after the last business day of each month.
21. Respondent shall submit an electronic spreadsheet that accounts for each payment

after the final payment on the Judgment.
