REINSTATEMENT ORDER

---

On this day, the matter of John W. Johnson (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent’s Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License was revoked pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2014-055 on April 8, 2014. In the order the Department found that the Respondent had failed to disclose his criminal background and failed to respond to A.I.D. inquiries.
2. The A.I.D. has received persuasive information that indicates the Respondent's criminal background contained erroneous information at the time of the revocation hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License is eligible to be reinstated.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4. Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License is hereby eligible for reinstatement and the revocation of the license is rescinded.

5. This Reinstatement Order shall rescind and replace A.I.D. Order No. 2014-55.
