SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day, the matter of Omar Rodriguez, ("Respondent") came before Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner") The Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDING OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer # 17737854.
2. Respondent's producer license in their home state of Florida is no longer active due to a Consent Order entered against him, which suspended his resident state license and issued a fine.
3. Respondent did not notify the Department of this Consent Order within thirty days as statutorily required.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

From the findings of Fact Contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann 23-64-508(a)(1)
4. In order to obtain a nonresident producer license in Arkansas, Ark. Code Ann 23-64-508(a)(1) requires that the person be licensed as a resident and in good standing in his or her home state.
5. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann 23-64-508(b) the Commissioner has the ability to summarily suspend a nonresident producer whose domiciliary state has suspended, revoked or otherwise terminated his or her resident producer license.
6. Pursuant to Ark Code Ann. 23-64-217(a)(1) Upon suspension of a license the Commissioner shall immediately notify licensee of suspension by mail to licensee at the licensee's address last of record with the Commissioner.
7. Upon presentation of sufficient evidence that a nonresident producer's home state license is active and in good standing, the suspension under this order shall be lifted as a matter of law pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. 23-64-508(b)(3)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Respondents Nonresident Producer License Number is hereby SUSPENDED. Respondent shall not, during the term of suspension, conduct the business of insurance in the state of Arkansas. Respondent is instructed that he/she may request an administrative hearing regarding this matter within thirty (30) days of the date of this Suspension Order.
