CONSENT ORDER

On this day, Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), and Brett Casey, ("Respondent") agree to enter into this Consent Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Brett Casey, holds an Arkansas Non-Resident Insurance Producer License, National Producer Number 15212640, and resides in Oklahoma.
2. Respondent holds a life and health line of authority insurance producer license.
3. In June of 2022, Respondent was terminated for cause by an insurer.
4. Respondent sent inappropriate and unprofessional electronic messages to persons engaged in the business of insurance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-103 et seq., and 23-64-501 et seq.

2. The Commissioner may suspend, revoke, order a civil fine, or place on probation any licensee for a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8): “Using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, lack of good personal or business reputation, or financial irresponsibility. . . .” Respondent’s actions were a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8).


3. Considering the Commissioner’s Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Respondent agrees to his insurance producer license being placed on probation.


4. Respondent expressly waives all further procedural steps, and expressly waives all rights to seek judicial review of or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. The Respondent’s Arkansas non-resident insurance producer license is hereby placed on probation for a period of two years.
