ORDER

On this day, the matter of the insurance producer license of Mr. Henry Alexander, ("Respondent") came before Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"). A hearing was held on April 5, 2023, in the Second Floor Hearing Room of the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") pursuant to the Notice of Hearing dated March 13, 2023. The hearing was held before Jimmy Harris, Compliance Manager, ("Hearing Officer") pursuant to his appointment by the Commissioner in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103(e)(1). The Department was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel. The Respondent was not present.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is a resident of Saline County.
2. Respondent holds an Arkansas insurance producer license.
3. A Notice of Hearing was sent to Respondent's last known address on March 13, 2023, by regular and certified mail and notice requirements have been met.
4. The Department received notification from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement ("OCSE") on October 31, 2022, that Respondent was three or more months in arrears as to court ordered child support payments.
5. Respondent's insurance producer license was suspended on December 30, 2022, as reflected in AID Order 2022-93.
6. Respondent has submitted proof that he has entered into an approved payment plan with OCSE, who has verified that Respondent's suspension may be rescinded.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction pursuant to the Arkansas Insurance Code, specifically Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-60-101 et seq.
2. It is a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14) to fail to comply with a court order that requires child support payments. Respondent's actions as described above were a violation of § 23-64-512(a)(14).
3. Respondent provided adequate proof from OCSE that he is now in compliance with his child support obligations.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, upon consideration of the evidence of record and the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Hearing officer recommends the following:

1. That the Respondent's insurance producer license be placed on probation for a period of three months.
2. That the order suspending Respondent's insurance producer license be rescinded.
