REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Nathaniel Kent (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 42100 and resides in Blytheville, Arkansas. Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2012-204 after the Department received notice from the Office of Child Support Enforcement that the Respondent was in arrears for three (3) or more months.
2. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2012-204 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239, the Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 42100 should be reinstated based upon correspondence received from the Office of Child Support Enforcement dated March 12, 2012 requesting reinstatement of the


Respondent's license.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 42100 is hereby REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.

5. This Reinstatement Order shall supersede A.I.D. Order No. 2012-204.
