On this day, the matter of Keith Harry Coleman ("Respondent") came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"). The Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") was represented by Amanda J. Andrews, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 300790, which became inactive on May 29, 2012 for failure to renew.
- 2. Respondent has completed the License Surrender Form available on the Department's website and submitted the form to the License Division of the Department.
- 3. Respondent has requested that he be allowed to freely and voluntarily surrender his Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 300790.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

4. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-61-103.

5. Respondent has the right to voluntarily surrender his Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 300790.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED:

In consideration of the above findings and conclusions, it is agreed that Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 300790 is voluntarily surrendered and will be placed in inactive status effective on the date of this order.
