REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Jeremy Taylor Nace (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 399247, which was suspended on July 8, 2014 by A.I.D. Order No. 2014-214 due to the inactive status of the Respondent’s resident state license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

2. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
3. Respondent’s producer license is limited to automobile or motor club products and governed by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-77-108.
4. Pursuant to Arkansas law regarding a license to sell automobile or motor club products, Respondent is entitled to have his license reinstated.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 399247 is hereby REINSTATED. This order supersedes A.I.D. Order No. 2014-214.
