EMERGENCY SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day, the matter of Nyaten Gaye (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds an Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License, National Producer Number 16555755. Respondent resides in Rhode Island.
2. On May 9, 2003, Respondent was convicted of Theft By Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Title 17-A §353, a misdemeanor, in the District Court of Biddeford, Maine.
3. Respondent stated she had never been convicted of a crime on her National Association of Insurance Commissioners Uniform Application. Respondent, in an email, stated she believed her criminal conviction had been expunged, when in fact, it had not.

4. Respondent's Iowa non-resident producer license was revoked with monetary penalty on June 1, 2014, for failure to respond.

5. Respondent's North Dakota non-resident producer was revoked on July 11, 2014, for failure to respond.

6. Respondent's Georgia non-resident producer license was suspended July 1, 2014, for failure to respond.

7. The Respondent did not inform the Petitioner that her licenses had been revoked within thirty days.

8. The public health, safety, and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

2. The Commissioner has the authority to issue an emergency license suspension pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-64-216(e) and 25-15-211(c).

3. Pursuant to the Arkansas Insurance Code, the Commissioner may suspend or revoke an insurance producer's license when any other state denies, suspends or revokes that state's producer license. *See* Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(9).


4. An administrative hearing will be held promptly, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-216(e)(2). A Notice of Hearing is being served herewith.

5. The Commissioner and the Department reserve the right to amend the allegations, findings and conclusions set forth herein and further reserve the right to present additional allegations and evidence in any subsequent order or administrative hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

In consideration of the Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License, National Producer Number 16555755, is hereby immediately suspended.
