## <u>ORDER</u>

Now on this day the matter of Change of Ownership of H.A. Burns Funeral Home, Inc. ("Respondent") is taken under consideration by Allen Kerr, Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), with the Arkansas Insurance Department (the "Department") appearing through managing attorney, Booth Rand, and from the facts, matters and other items before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:

## FINDINGS PRESENTED

- 1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the sale and licensing of prepaid funeral benefit contracts and prepaid funeral benefit organizations in this State under Ark. Code Ann. §23-40-107(a).
- 2. The Respondent, H.A. Burns Funeral Home, Inc. ("Seller") is licensed by the Department to transact prepaid funeral benefit contracts in this State. The Seller desires to transfer ownership of its prepaid funeral benefit contracts to Denver-Roller, Inc. dba Assured Peace Funeral Plan ("Buyer"). The Buyer is also licensed by the Department as a prepaid funeral benefit organization.
- 3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-40-122(c), the Commissioner is required to approve a transfer or change of ownership of prepaid funeral benefits contracts.

4. The Department has received, reviewed and approved the proposed change of

ownership. Based on the Seller's detailed list of outstanding and unfulfilled prepaid contracts, as

of February 4, 2015, the outstanding amount of annuity-funded prepaid contracts to be

transferred and assumed by the Buyer total \$4,180.00; the outstanding and unfulfilled insurance-

funded prepaid contracts total \$26,121.00; and the outstanding and unfulfilled trust-funded

prepaid contracts total \$971,083.96.00.

5. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-40-113(c), the Commissioner hereby finds: 1)

the Buyer set forth in the application holds a valid, current permit pursuant to the provisions of

the Arkansas Prepaid Funeral Benefits Law; 2) the accounting required is complete and accurate;

and 3) all additional information and documents have been filed with and approved by the

Department. The Buyer has also tendered the requisite filing fees. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §

23-40-113(d), the Commissioner waives any additional requirements not necessary or

appropriate in the public interest or for the protection of contract buyers.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Commissioner hereby approves the above described change of ownership

between Buyer and Seller under Ark. Code Ann. § 23-40-113(c).
