ORDER

On this day, the emergency matter of John Dyer (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 352389. Respondent’s Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2012-041 on January 25, 2012, due to the inactive status of Respondent's home state resident license.

2. Respondent has petitioned to voluntarily surrender his Arkansas Non-Resident Producer license and has completed the license surrender form.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Respondent has the right to request that he be allowed to voluntarily surrender his license.

4. The Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 352389 should be considered voluntarily surrendered and the suspension should be lifted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5. Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 352389 is hereby surrendered and placed on inactive status. Any previous suspension of the license is lifted.

6. This Order shall rescind and replace A.I.D. Order No. 2012-41.
