ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Now on this day the matter of Arkansas Certificate of Registration of DOCTORS & SURGEONS NATIONAL RISK RETENTION GROUP IC, INC., NAIC No. 13018 (“Company”), is taken under consideration by Allen Kerr, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas (“Commissioner”), as presented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, Legal Division of the Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) and by the Finance Division of the Department. From the facts, matters and other things before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Company is a risk retention group covering commercial liability domiciled in Vermont.
2. The Company was granted an Arkansas Certificate of Registration pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-94-205.
3. The Company no longer meets the minimum capital and surplus requirements of its domiciliary state and was placed in rehabilitation on October 7, 2016, by order of the Washington County Superior Court of Vermont.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter involved herein.

5. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-63-212(a)(3) and 23-94-212, the Commissioner concludes that the Company's Arkansas Certificate of Registration should be suspended due to the Company's financially troubled status in its state of domicile.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Arkansas Certificate of Registration of Doctors & Surgeons National Risk Retention Group IC, Inc. is hereby immediately suspended.
