REINSTATEMENT ORDER

---

On this day, the matter of Raymond Baham (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 17737199 and resides in Pine Bluff, Arkansas. Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No.2017-002 on January 4, 2017.

2. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2017-002 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239, the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 17737199 should be reinstated based upon correspondence received from the Office of Child Support Enforcement dated January 13, 2017, requesting reinstatement of the Respondent's license.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 17737199 is hereby REINSTATED effective January 13, 2017, and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.

5. This Reinstatement Order shall rescind and replace A.I.D. Order No. 2017-002.
