REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the emergency matter of John Hendrix (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent previously held Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 381891 and is a licensed insurance producer in Tennessee. Respondent’s Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2013-002 because he had no active home state license.
2. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2013-002 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License should be reinstated based upon information showing Respondent's Tennessee Producer License is currently in good standing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4. Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License is hereby eligible to be REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.

5. This Reinstatement Order shall rescind and replace A.I.D. Order No. 2013-002.
