### NOTICE OF HEARING

Dear Mrs. Chism:

You are hereby notified that an administrative hearing has been scheduled pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-303 and 23-64-216(e), and other applicable provisions of Arkansas law, before Insurance Commissioner Alan McClain, as Hearing Officer, or his designee, on November 30, 2021, at 10:00 AM in the Second Floor Hearing Room, Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"), 1 Commerce Way, Little Rock, Arkansas, 72202. The purpose of this hearing is to determine whether your producer license should be revoked for failure to comply with applicable Arkansas law as per Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a). You are alleged to have violated the following requirements:

1. You failed to disclose a felony criminal conviction with your original resident insurance producer license application, a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(1).
2. You have been convicted of a felony, previously undisclosed, a violation of § 23-64-512(a)(6). Specifically, you were convicted of "Misprision of a Felony" 18 U.S.C. § 4, a class E felony, in 2014, US. Eastern District of Arkansas Federal Case No: 4:12CR00130-04 BSM.
3. Your license has been suspended or revoked by insurance regulators in other states, a violation of § 23-64-512(a)(2). Specifically, your non-resident producer license was revoked in California, Virginia, Wisconsin, Washington, and Louisiana.

4. You failed to report the administrative actions as described in paragraph 3 to the Department within 30 days, a violation of § 23-64-517(a)(1).
5. You have failed to maintain your correct resident address with the Department, a violation of § 23-64-507(f).

You have the right to represent yourself or be represented by counsel of your own choosing at this proceeding. Additionally, the Commissioner will obtain a competent reporter to record the hearing. You may avail yourself of other privileges, including the Department's assistance to subpoena any needed witnesses or records.

Your verbal or written notification that you have received this notice of hearing must be received in this office within ten (10) days of your receipt. If your notification is not received by the Department within ten (10) days, any and all expenses incurred by the Department in continuing the hearing or in notification of witnesses, including but not limited to, phone calls, issuance of subpoenas and postage, will be charged to the party or parties requesting such continuance. If you or your attorney determines that a continuance is necessary, or you have questions or concerns, please contact me at (501) 371-2829.
