**CONSENT REVOCATION ORDER**

On this day, Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”), and Kyle Evans (“Respondent”) agree to enter into this Consent Revocation Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent is a resident insurance producer.
3. Respondent, while working as an insurance producer at a State Farm agency, was terminated for cause for allegedly submitting several health policy applications that were not signed by policy holders.
4. Respondent, after receiving proper notice, failed to attend an investigative conference on December 6, 2017, and failed to respond to the conference notice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. For the above actions, Respondent is in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-64-201 (h), 23-64-512(a)(17) and (8).

9. Considering the Commissioner's Conclusions of Law, the Respondent voluntarily surrenders his producer license for revocation by the Department.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:

10. All licenses issued by the Department to Kyle Evans are hereby revoked.
