REVOCATION ORDER

---

On this day, the matter of the producer’s license of Danielle Lamberth (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). A hearing was held on October 23, 2018, in the First Floor Hearing Room of the Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) pursuant to the Notice of Hearing dated October 15, 2018. The hearing was held before William Lacy (“Hearing Officer”) pursuant to his appointment by the Commissioner in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103(e)(1). The Department was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel. The Respondent did not appear.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction pursuant to the Arkansas Insurance Code, specifically Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-60-101, *et seq.*
2. Respondent is a resident of Faulkner County.
3. Respondent holds a Arkansas resident producer license, NPN 17502348.

4. Respondent was sent notice of hearing by regular and certified mail to her last known address provided to the Department.

5. Respondent was charged with felony possession of a controlled substance on January 25, 2018

6. Respondent was convicted of felony possession of a controlled substance on September 11, 2018, in Garland County Circuit Court Case 26CR-18-46.

7. Respondent failed to inform the Department of her arrest or conviction.

8. Respondent's producer license was suspended on October 10, 2018, by A.I.D. Order 2018-90.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(6) authorizes the Department to revoke an insurance producer's license for being convicted of a felony. Respondent's actions were a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(6).

2. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-201(e) requires a producer to notify the commission in writing upon being charged or convicted of a crime. Respondent's failure to notify the commission of her arrest or conviction was a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-201(e).

RECOMMENDATION OF HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, upon consideration of the evidence of record and the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Hearing officer recommends the following:

1. That the Arkansas resident insurance producer license of the Respondent be revoked.
