REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, the matter of the adjuster’s license of Harold Holiday (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). A hearing was held on October 8, 2018, in the First Floor Hearing Room of the Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) pursuant to the Notice of Hearing dated September 14, 2018. The hearing was held before Chief Deputy Commissioner Russ Galbraith (“Hearing Officer”) pursuant to his appointment by the Commissioner in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103(e)(1). The Department was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel. The Respondent did not appear.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction pursuant to the Arkansas Insurance Code, specifically Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-60-101, *et seq.*
2. Respondent is a resident of Benton County.
3. Respondent holds a Arkansas resident adjuster license NPN 17520881.
4. On July 31, 2018, the Department received notice from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement that the Respondent is three (3) or more

months in arrearage on his child support obligation.

5. On September 11, 2018, the Respondent's adjuster license was suspended by A.I.D. Order 2018-88.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Commissioner is required to suspend the Respondent's adjuster license pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239(d) upon notice from the Office of Child Support Enforcement that a licensee is three (3) or more months in arrears on a child support obligation.

2. Under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-216(a)(2)(M), the failure to comply with an order imposing a child support obligation is grounds for suspension or revocation of an adjuster's license. Respondent's actions are a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-216(a)(2)(M),

RECOMMENDATION OF HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, upon consideration of the evidence of record and the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Hearing officer recommends the following:

1. That the Arkansas resident insurance adjuster license of the Respondent be revoked.
