REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the emergency matter of Andrew Fleming ("Respondent") came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"). The Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") was represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a licensed insurance producer from Saline County. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2018-020 on February 15, 2018, for failure to make child support payments.
- 2. Respondent has provided proof from the Office of Child Support Enforcement that he is in compliance with a payment plan and fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2018-020 to the Commissioner's satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License should be reinstated based upon information from the Office of Child Support Enforcement that he is in compliance with his court ordered child support obligations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 4. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License is hereby eligible to be REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.
- 5. This Reinstatement Order shall rescind and replace A.I.D. Order No. 2018-020.
