CONSENT REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”), and Stephen Pitts (“Respondent”) agree to enter into this Consent Revocation Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent is a non-resident insurance producer residing in Utah.
3. Respondent, while working as an insurance producer for eHeath Insurance Services, Inc., was terminated for cause by United Health Care for enrolling several customers for Medicare Advantage plans without their consent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. For the above actions, Respondent is in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8).

5. Considering the Commissioner's Conclusions of Law, the Respondent voluntarily surrenders his producer license for revocation by the Department.


THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:
