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**ORDER**

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On this day, the matter of Alliance Insurance Group of Arkadelphia, Inc. (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent holds an Arkansas Resident Business Entity License, National Producer Number 1650844, which was suspended on April 17, 2018, by A.I.D. Order No. 2018-42 due to the alleged fraudulent activity conducted through the Respondent. The Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2018-42 are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Berry R. Bishop was the sole incorporator and owner of the Respondent.
3. On or about May 30, 2018, the Respondent commenced a voluntary petition for relief in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Arkansas (“Bankruptcy Court”), Case No. 6:18-BK-71472.
4. In correspondence dated September 17, 2018, Mr. Bishop requested the surrender of the Respondent’s Arkansas Resident business Entity License (“License”) pending approval by

the Bankruptcy Court.

5. On October 2, 2018, the Trustee in the Respondent's bankruptcy proceedings filed a Notice of Intent to Abandon the Respondent's License as an asset in the Respondent's case.

6. On October 22, 2018, the Bankruptcy Court issued an Order Granting Trustee's Notice of Intent to Abandon Debtor's Arkansas Insurance License ("Bankruptcy Court Order").

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

7. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

8. The Bankruptcy Court Order allows the Respondent to seek a voluntary surrender the License issued it by the Department, which Respondent has requested.

### IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED:

In consideration of the above findings and conclusions, it is agreed that Respondent's Arkansas Resident Business Entity License, National Producer Number 1650844, is voluntarily surrendered and will be placed in inactive status as of the date of this Order. This Order shall supersede the provisions of A.I.D. Order No. 2018-42 affecting Respondent's License only and shall have no force or effect regarding the suspension of the Arkansas Resident Producer License of Berry R. Bishop.
