VOLUNTARY SURRENDER ORDER

On this day, the matter of Tiffany Hendricks (“Respondent”) came before Allen Kerr, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Gray Allen Turner, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent formerly held an Arkansas Non-Resident Insurance Producer License. Respondent resides in Missouri.
2. The Respondent's non-resident insurance producer license was suspended by AID Case No. 2011-117, on October 4, 2011, due to having no active home state insurance producer license.
3. The Respondent has submitted a voluntary surrender of her Arkansas Non-Resident Insurance Producer License.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. The Respondent's license suspension shall be rescinded.
3. The Respondent's Arkansas Non-Resident Insurance Producer License is eligible to be reinstated upon providing proof of an active resident license.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

In consideration of the Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Insurance Producer License, National Producer Number 9595004, has been voluntarily surrendered and is eligible to be reinstated upon application and proof of an active resident state license. This order supersedes AID Case No. 2011-117 and 2019-12.
